Class Descriptions

Leadline: Open to children six (6) years of age or under. Not eligible for any other non-leadline classes.

Pleasure Division: Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales in flat classes.

Mini Stirrup: Open to juniors eight (8) years and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at the same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to children twelve(12) years of age and under on horses and ponies who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Fences at x-rails.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combo may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Pleasure at the same show.

Beginner Equitation: Open to all juniors who have not shown in more than eight (8) horse shows in any one year. Fences at x-rails. Riders cannot jump higher than 2' in any horse show and may only cross enter into Modified Hunter.

Lesson Mount: Open to all riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Rider may not have shown higher than x-rails at any show. May use any tack used in a schooling program. Fences at cross rails.

Walk/Trot: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes.

Modified Hunter: Open to all Junior and Adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq, 2' Eq, or pleasure at same show. Fences to be at 2'

Thoroughbred Hunter: AHS points Open to all thoroughbred horses/ponies that are full thoroughbred s. Judged on performance, way of going and soundness. Fences to be 2'3" or 2'9" at riders discretion. Not to be combined with any other division. **Baby Green Hunter**: Open to horses or ponies who are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

Low Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2' or 2'3 at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form.

High Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2'6 or 3' at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form.

Pre-Children's Hunter Horse/Pony: Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Horses to jump at 2'6", Ponies to jump 2'. May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division on same mount.

Children's Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors. Small/medium ponies, fences 2'. Large ponies, fences 2'6" and horses, fences 3'.

Pre-Adult/ Low Hunter: Open to adult amateur riders on either ponies or horses. Fence heights to be at 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup Division at the same show.

Long Stirrup: Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter.

Developing Hunter: Open to all horses/ponies in their 1 st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Division to have walk/trot, walk/trot/canter, and 2 simple crossrai ls over fences classes. Simple changes and trotting corners not penalized. May cross enter into Baby Green

Junior/Adult Pleasure: Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or Adult. Judged on permmance manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No Martingales

2'-2'3" Novice Equitation: Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at riders discretion. May be combined with Open Equitation

2'6" - 2'9" Open Equitation: Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2'6" or 2'9" at riders discretion. May be combined with Novice Equitation. **Low Schooling Jumpers.** Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 2 or 2'3". Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions).

High Schooling Jumpers: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 2'6" or3'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min).

TB Jumpers (NON AHS Points): Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be approx 2'9'-3'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min).


AHS. Entry fees collected will go into the AHS Helping Hooves Fund which gives financial aid to members in need. Open to all horses and ponies who have been competing this year at 2'6" or higher and enter and pay in full for at least one division at this show. Horses and ponies may be ridden by any rider in the Derby. There will be no separate schooling for the Derby. The AHS Derby will run as a two round class. The first round is judged as a Hunter Classic with an emphasis on style and brilliance over a course of fences found typically in the hunt field. The second round is judged as a Handy Hunter with an emphasis placed on style, brilliance, and rideability. Top 8 competitors will be called back to ride in the second round. The 2'6" Derby will have 2'9" options.

DERBY PARTICIPANTS:

Riders do not need to be an AHS Member to compete in the Derby. Horse/Pony must compete in a division at the show in order to enter the Derby. If you wish to go for year-end points in the Derbies, then you must have a current AHS membership for horse, rider, and owner.
